

## Notice of Race

### **1. Rules**

1.1. The regatta is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

### **2. Eligibility and Entry**

2.1. The regatta is open to all boats of the Penguin class.

2.2. Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form and paying the fee on April 1, 2006, by 11:30

### **3. Fees**

3.1. The entry fee is \$15, there is a National Park Service boat launch fee of approximately \$6.

### **4. Schedule**

4.1. 1000 – 1130 Registration

4.2. 1130 - 1140 Skipper's Meeting

4.3. 1215 First Warning Signal

4.4. 1430 No further warning signals/racing

### **5. Sailing Instructions**

5.1. Sailing Instructions will be available at Registration

### **6. Venue**

6.1. Racing will be in the cove off the Washington Sailing Marina, 1 Marina Drive, Alexandria, VA.

6.2. The Washington Sailing Marina is located south of Reagan National Airport, off of the George Washington Memorial Parkway.

### **7. Courses**

7.1. Courses shall consist of windward leeward laps and/or triangle laps.

### **8. Penalty System**

8.1. Rules 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.

### **9. Scoring**

9.1. The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A applies. When six or more races have been completed, a boats score will be the total of her race scores, excluding here worst score.

9.2. One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

### **10. Prizes**

10.1. Prizes will be awarded for First, Second, and Third Place.
